

## Tennessee State 4-H Horse Championships

### Changes for 2009

Graduating Seniors will be recognized at the Banquet on Tuesday Evening. They must indicate if they are attending the banquet on their HORSE SHOW ENTRY FORM and submit a Graduating Senior Form along with their entry form. Graduating Seniors are also encouraged to either send in photos (to me via mail or email) or bring poster boards to the banquet representing their 4-H career to display.

Those that may attend the banquet Free of Charge are the following: Graduating Seniors, State Judging Contest Exhibitors (and coaches), State Speech and Demonstration Winners, and Special Award Winners (Including Invited Guests). **ALL OTHERS (INCLUDING FAMILY MEMBERS) MAY ATTEND THE BANQUET AT A \$10.00 PER PERSON FEE AND MUST INDICATE NUMBER OF ATTENDEES ON THEIR STATE ENTRY FORM.** Paid banquet attendees will receive banquet tickets which they must present at the door. Those wishing to attend the banquet will need to include the Banquet Fee(s) with their state entry fees.

Two new conformation classes have been added to the Ranch Division. The Ranch Division will be awarded a high point, but these will not be qualifying classes for Southern Regionals or points classes for the Western Division High Point.. Please remember, Ranch Entries may not cross enter into Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, or Western Halter, but they may cross enter into Trail, Showmanship and Reining.

Please note the Saddle English Division is now referred to as the Saddle Seat Division.
