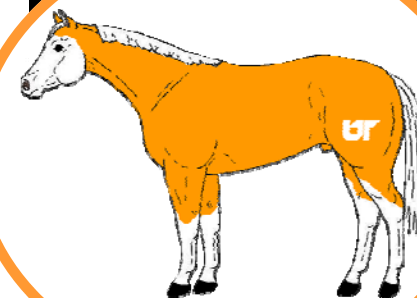

Welcome to the inaugural running of **The University of Tennessee Youth Horse Judging Camp!**

The **2009 UT Youth Horse Judging Camp** is a 3-Day event aimed at providing youth with invaluable knowledge pertaining to the judging of horses in a low-stress environment.
