Position Title: Animal Management Intern

Requirements:

- Pursuing the BS degree at the University of Tennessee
- Preference given to students in Animal Science, but all are encouraged to apply
- Must have completed Animal Science 220 and Animal Science 280
- Previous hands-on animal experience desired
- Preference given to students with leadership in clubs, judging teams and other related extracurricular activities
- Must complete IACUC and OHP training

Responsibilities: Assist with daily care of teaching animals. This may include, but not limited to, sows, newborn pigs, market hogs, market lambs, chickens and beef and dairy cattle. Duties include, but not limited to, animal movement and restraint, animal processing, individual animal ID, daily feeding and cleaning and other animal techniques as needed. For an unpaid 3-hour internship, the requirement is 9 hours per week for 15 weeks, thus a total of 135 hours must be worked within the semester.

Scheduling: It is anticipated that there will be 2-3 interns and every attempt will be made to accommodate most schedules, but there will be some night, weekend and holiday work. Preference given to students who can work over spring break, include availability in letter.

Salary: One to three hours credit under Animal Science 492 (Internship in Animal Science).
