Position Title: Animal Management Intern/Sheep Show Team

Requirements:

- Pursuing the BS degree at the University of Tennessee
- Preference given to students in Animal Science, but all are encouraged to apply
- Preference given to students who have completed Animal Science 220 and Animal Science 280, but all are encouraged to apply
- Preference given to students with leadership in clubs, judging teams and other related extracurricular activities
- Must complete IACUC and OHP training

Responsibilities: Assist with daily care of teaching animals. This may include, but not limited to, sows, newborn pigs, market hogs, market lambs and pregnant ewes. Duties include, but not limited to, animal movement and restraint, animal processing, individual animal ID, daily feeding and cleaning and other animal techniques as needed. Additionally, students will be charged with preparing, grooming and showing sheep at North American International Livestock Exposition in November.

Scheduling: 1-2 students with substantial sheep showing experience will be chosen to serve as the show team chair and 2-3 students with little to no sheep showing experience will also be chosen. Every attempt will be made to accommodate most schedules, but there will be some night, weekend and holiday work. Preference given to students who can work over fall break, include availability in letter.

Salary: 3 hours credit under Animal Science 492 (Internship in Animal Science).
