Position Title: Feed Mill Operations Internship

Requirements:

- Pursuing OR completed the BS degree at the University of Tennessee
- Preference given to students in Animal Science or Biosystems Engineering and Soil Science, but all are encouraged to apply
- Successful candidate is expected to maintain a record of experiences, along with photos, in order to give a presentation at the end of the internship

Part-time: 12-15 hours per week

Responsibilities: Assist with the operation of the feed mill located at the Johnson Animal Research and Teaching Unit (JARTU). Intern will work with the JARTU Supervisor in areas that include, but are not limited to, feed mill maintenance, feed mixing, ingredient procurement, and feed bagging.

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Intern will possibly be eligible to receive credit through Animal Science 492 (Animal Science Internship).

Availability: Review of applications will begin September 15, 2010, and continue until a suitable candidate is found. The internship would then be available immediately through November 30, 2010 (Fall semester) and January 12, 2011, through April 29, 2011 (Spring semester).
